This often involves no work. The sentence/word simply needs to be verbally repeated/used from time to time.
How can you support your child at home?	

You can best support your child by supervising them loudly reading over their lesson, even if just once on a weekend, and then using the vocab they learn at school (which can be found in the booklet/start of each lesson in exercise books) in order to get them more accustomed to the word. This will also assist them in remembering the word.

Please ensure they complete their homework which is often only 15/20mins per week and extremely useful in ensuring what they learn is retained.

Encourage them to use the Arabic they learn in daily life as much as possible, and you'll find yourself learning some unintentionally too!
