What are we currently learning in lessons?

- We are nearing the end of a unit of study on Elizabeth I. Students have covered areas of her reign including her early life, steps to deal with religious conflict, use of propaganda to help her gain support as a female ruler and the war with Spain.
- The end of the unit will focus on using the content from these topics to examine how she dealt with the challenges facing England at the time and how successful she was in each area.
- This analysis will be used to support and assessment which asks students to evaluate her reign and why she is considered one of England's most successful monarchs.
