Last day arrangements/ Phased Dismissal

Reminder that both schools will be closing early this Friday 31st March. To ensure a separate, safe, and organised dismissal process, we will be implementing a phased dismissal as outlined below. Students eligible for school meals will collect their meal at break.

Madani Girls School: 12:00 – 12.20PM

MGS Students are expected to complete individual prayer at home due to earlier release.

Madani Boys School: 12:20 – 12.40PM

MBS Students are expected to go directly to their local Masjid and may complete Jumuah at Madani Masjid. Vulnerable students or those who are who are not able to get to their local Masjid in time due to distance will be expected to pray with staff in the dining hall.

Text messages/ MCAS/ Parent & Carer Engagement
