- Assignments will be set on Microsoft Teams covering a select number of subjects for students to
 complete over the two days there will be no live lessons. A reminder on how to access
 assignments will be sent to your child via their school email address.
- Your child will be required to register their attendance online on each of the days by 10:30AM
 there will be a link available on the homepage of the school website which will also be emailed to students.
- Students with Educational Healthcare Plans (EHCP's) will be contacted by a member of staff from the Ansaar team to offer personalised support.
- If your child has any technical queries, they can email: <u>it@madani.leicester.sch.uk</u> providing their name, form class and details of their query. A member of the IT Helpdesk will be in touch.
- If your child requires any subject based support in relation to the work set, they can contact the relevant subject leaders via email. Contact details can be found on the school website.

All students will return to school as normal on Tuesday 30th August (after Bank Holiday Monday) by 8:10AM in their full uniform, including ID card as required.

Furthermore, please also note that as the works includes an expansion to the school kitchen area, catering will be impacted as a result of the work taking place and therefore the breakfast, break and lunch menus will be running on a limited menu for a short period. As a reminder breakfast club commences each school day from 7.30am and can be accessed from reception.

Parking/ Student drop off and collection

As mentioned in previous letters, you are strongly encouraged particularly with works around the school site to advise your child to 'active travel' by walking or cycling to school. Walking and cycling are free and easy ways to stay fit and healthy and reduce traffic at the school gates. If you must travel to school by car, please try and find a safe and suitable location to get dropped off a short walk away from the school.

We have previously had a student involved in a car accident. Incidents like this can be avoided by minimising car use near the school, on kerb parking which restricts visibility for students and pedestrians

and strictly avoiding dropping off students in the middle of the road – this is both dangerous and unfair on other drivers – you will be aware that this is not in line with our school ethos and falls below the expectations of the school from our learning community. Please assist us in keeping our children safe and healthy.
